Valentine's Day began with Saint Valentine, a priest in Ancient Rome. During a time when Emperor Claudius II banned marriages for young men, believing single men made better soldiers, Valentine secretly continued to marry couples. When he was caught, he was sentenced to death. While in jail, he fell in love with the jailer's daughter and wrote her a farewell letter signed "From your Valentine." Over time, February 14 became a day to celebrate love, and the tradition spread around the world, becoming a global symbol of romance.
